MISSION STATEMENT:

The mission of Huber's Stella di Luce Art & Wine Show has always been to celebrate our winemaking team by highlighting their vision and art of winemaking with the release of our seasonal wine "Stella di Luce". Just as winemakers are artists, we wanted to also highlight other professionals in our local art community that share this same passion. Stella di Luce, meaning "star of light", highlights our community of Starlight, our winemaking team, and the immense artistic talent that we are surrounded by in our local community.

The Art & Wine Show concept was created so that our guests could not only enjoy a sip of the seasonal dry rose wine thoughtfully named "Stella di Luce" but also be exposed to the beautiful work of select local artists. Our goal each year is to plan a show filled with great, local art that we know our guests will enjoy when visiting and enjoying a glass of Stella di Luce.

This year we are expanding our normal 6-artist show to the hopes of 40 artists, with our goal to include artists from past shows as well as new local talent. This show has typically been held in the Garden Room, but this year we are reserving space in our beautiful Plantation Hall facility!

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Stella di Luce show is a two-day event to showcase art of all mediums. Additional activities of this show include wine tasting, live music, and commemorative posters for purchase.

The show will take place in our banquet facility, Plantation Hall, which is located adjacent to the Winery. Booth spaces of 10'x10' will be provided. It will be the artists' responsibility to provide their own tables, shelves, faux walls, etc. Nothing will be allowed to be nailed to the walls or ceiling of our facility. Electricity will be

provided, with limited outlets available. If you require electricity, please provide your own extension cords to pull power to your space.

The room is very large, with a high ceiling, so tent type set-ups will fit but are not necessary. If that type of “booth” is required for your artistic presence, you may be required to show examples prior to set up day to ensure it will not hinder the presence of the booths that surround you. Please let us know if you plan to bring this type of set up, so we can talk about approval.

Depending on placement of your booth, sides and back of booth may be visible. We plan to send a room layout prior to show date to show placement. All tables must be skirted to the floor or ground. Nothing may be attached to any walls or windows of the permanent structures on our property.

8-foot tables are available for rent for \$5 each. Supply is limited to 30 tables. This will be an add-on option when you register online. Limit two per artist.

PUBLICITY

A postcard will be designed, produced, and distributed to each artist to send/share with customers. Advertisements and posts will be made to areas such as: Huber’s website, Huber’s Facebook & Instagram, New Albany News and Tribune, Leo, Salem Leader, Banner Gazette, and local news and radio stations.

ART SELECTION

When selecting items for this show, please ensure that the pieces you choose are family friendly.

PAYMENT & SALES TAX

All artists are responsible for collecting payment at their booth and paying their own taxes where appropriate. Wi-Fi will be provided; so wireless credit card terminals may be used.

SECURITY

This is an indoor event. Show spaces will be locked and alarm monitored overnight.

REFRESHMENTS

Lunch will be provided daily (excluding setup day) in a private area, including various options, served buffet style. Coffee, water, and soft drinks are complimentary.

Food preferences and intolerances cannot be accommodated. If meal options provided do not suffice, the Starlight Café in the Winery offers various sandwiches, appetizers, and pizzas for purchase.
