



As we resume our usual operations, the Huber Team is continuing to follow safety and sanitization protocols in place, as well as adding more, when needed. The comfort and safety of our customers and employees is still our primary concern.

We have hand sanitation stations at different points throughout the Farm for use by customers and employees. Employees are completing a wellness assessment before reporting to work and are required to wear face coverings. We ask that guests also assess their health before visiting us, and all guests must wear a face covering while indoors, unless seated at a table or eating/drinking, and outdoors while waiting for or riding a U-pick wagon or if it is otherwise not possible to socially distance.

We are adhering to a reduced maximum capacity for each building or area, and the reduced capacity for each area is posted outside entrances. We are continuing to practice extensive sanitizing procedures in all public and private areas. With respect to specific areas of our business we will be doing the following:

Our on-premise dining is now available with both indoor and outdoor seating. Guests indoors may remove their face coverings when seated at a table. Tables have been placed at least 6 feet apart and will seat no more than 6 people per table. We ask that guests do not move tables or chairs from their original positions, and we will require that groups larger than 6 be seated at more than one table. Customers may not bring their own lawn chairs or other seating for use in our immediate outdoor areas.

The Starlight Café continues to offer carryout and call-ahead orders for guests who do not wish to dine on-premise. Guests who visit us to place or pick up orders for either dine in or carryout are asked to adhere to social distancing guidelines at all times. To reduce the number of people in indoor spaces we ask that guests limit the number of people in your party waiting in line or standing in indoor common areas. Please look for posted signage for guidance in all indoor areas. When possible, we ask that your party remain at your table or in outdoor areas.

Tastings have resumed at the bars in the Tasting Loft, which has been set up to accommodate social distancing. We are adding additional tasting locations, including an outdoor tent for Fall. We can accommodate walk-ins as space allows, and please continue to be patient with our procedures and limited resources. *Wine Club tastings will continue to be limited to member and Co-Member only.*

Our Farm Park is open regular hours. We have added max capacity signage for interior buildings, added extra sanitization protocols for all surfaces, and are asking all guests to maintain appropriate social distancing requirements. Face coverings are not required outdoors in our Farm Park unless it is not possible to socially distance.

U-Pick is ongoing, and we have implemented procedures and protocols in the outdoor areas to reinforce social distancing guidelines for guests waiting to board U-pick wagons. We are utilizing double the usual number of wagons to accommodate decreased capacity, and are assigning U-pick "zones" for each U-pick group. Guests must wear face coverings while waiting for or riding U-pick wagons.

The Farm Market and Ice Cream Factory are open, as usual, with limited capacity, enhanced sanitation practices, and social distancing enforced. Seasonal Produce is available for purchase in the Farm Market, along with dry goods, sweets, and bakery items. Face coverings are required for all guests and employees while inside these buildings, unless eating or drinking.

Plantation Hall has resumed scheduling of events, with limited capacity. We can now accommodate events up to 250. Please call or email our event coordinators with questions or to schedule events.
